

# Rye Sustainability Committee 2017 Accomplishments

### Energy

 Organized a free <u>Home Energy Efficiency Workshop</u> for the public at the Rye Free Reading Room.

## Water/Land Use

- Launched Tree Fund
  - Solicited over \$6,300 in donations for the planning, purchasing and planting of eight native <u>street trees at different locations</u> around the City
- Rye Healthy Yard (RHYP) program
  - o Held a *How to Talk to Your Landscaper About Going Organic* workshop
  - o Held a RHYP Landscapers' forum at Jay Heritage Center
  - Increased <u>Rye Healthy Yard pledges</u> to over 100 families and organizations
  - Organized five neighborhood coffees
  - o Created a RHYP Landscapers' Directory
- Hosted with Eastchester Environmental Committee, a leach mulching demonstration.

#### Waste Reduction/Recycling

- Compiled a *Where do I Recycle/Donate?* guide for residents.
- Launched *Put a Cork in It* cork recycling initiative.
- Hosted two Green Screen film events that focused on waste reduction:
  - Minimalism
  - o WASTED!

#### Community Awareness/Outreach

- Acted as a sounding board for local org and individuals:
  - o Advice for Rye Town in setting up a sustainability committee

- Launched and announced the first Rye Sustainability Leadership Award
