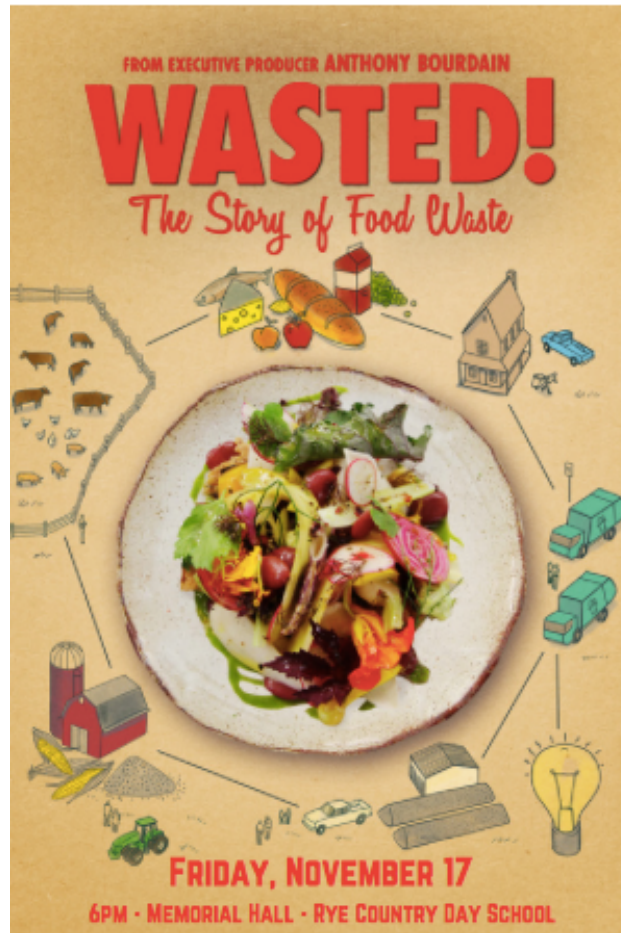


# WASTED! *The Story of Food Waste*
